

Conflict Minerals Statement



Tosca does not have any direct obligations in respect of Conflict Minerals as per Regulation (EU) 2017/821 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 May 2017 laying down supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas or Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.

However, as we use steel and electronics in our products, offices and across our business we feel we have an obligation to require our suppliers of such goods, to undertake reasonable due diligence within their supply chain to identify and document the source of origin of Conflict Minerals.

As such we require such suppliers to sign our Supplier Code of Conduct which clearly states our expectations regarding Conflict Minerals.
